

MEMORANDUM OF FRIENDSHIP EXCHANGE AND ECONOMIC COOPERATION

BETWEEN

THE CITY OF SHENZHEN OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

AND

THE CITY OF CANBERRA, THE AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY OF

AUSTRALIA

Both Canberra and Shenzhen (hereinafter referred to as "both sides"), through amicable negotiations and represented respectively by Ms. Katy Gallagher, Chief Minister of Australian Capital Territory and Mr. Xu Qin, Mayor of Shenzhen, agree on signing this "Memorandum of Friendship Exchange and Economic Cooperation between the City of Shenzhen of the People's Republic of China and the City of Canberra, Australian Capital Territory" and reaching the following intentions to further increase friendship, to expand exchanges and economic cooperation, and to enhance friendly relations between the two sides:

- 1) Both sides, under the principle of equality and mutual benefit, mutual trust and common development, agree to conduct exchanges and cooperation on wider areas of shared interest including technology, innovation, industry, and other areas from time to time, to facilitate extensive and pragmatic exchanges and cooperation. Both sides will invite delegations to attend major events held in their respective cities in the areas of shared interest.
- 2) Both sides agree to keep regular exchanges between senior government officials and their agencies so that negotiations on exchanges and cooperation and on issues of common interest can be conducted.
- 3) Both sides agree to enhance friendship and bilateral cultural exchanges between the people of Canberra and Shenzhen through governmental and community efforts.


- 4) Both sides agree to promote two-way investment and cooperation between the companies and institutions of Canberra and Shenzhen.
- 5) The details of the exchanges and cooperation will be coordinated by the international relationships office of each side and developed upon by the relevant and responsible areas of government of each side.

Both sides agree to sign this Memorandum of Friendship Exchange and Economic Cooperation.

This Memorandum is written in Chinese and English with two copies of each being treated as equal. This Memorandum will take effect upon its signing in Shenzhen on October 14, 2014.
